### Countries or Areas in the Sex and Age Disaggregation Process

#### Frequency of annual reporting of Population by sex and age

Countries or areas having *not* reported population by sex and age over the period of 1995-2003.

- ✓ \*: partial report: reported data for one to four of nine years
- ✓ **Afghanistan**: Listed by the UN as least developed countries  
(At the last review (2003), the UN defined LDCs based on 3 criteria, with a country needing to meet all three to be considered an LDC. One of the criteria is based on a three-year average estimate of the gross national income (GNI) per capita, where income is under \$750. Countries with populations over 75m are excluded)
- ✓ **Angola**: Have been or were under a UN Peacekeeping operation (1995-2006).
- ✓ #: Listed as small island developing state or areas (UN classification)
